## Funds and Bursaries

### College Bursary

You may be entitled to the College Bursary if you meet certain criteria and are from a low income household (under £26,000 per year). This could qualify you for help with travel costs or/and free college meals.

All applications need to be completed online [HERE](#). Even if you applied and received bursary, including Free College Meals, during the last academic year, you will still need to reapply this year for 2021-2022.
